

## Emergency Movement of Equipment

1. Pursuant to Section 10(1) of the Commercial Vehicle Dimension and Weight Regulation, a vehicle moving to or transporting equipment to a forest fire, flood, train derailment, pipeline spill or other emergency is exempt from having to comply with section 4 (Maximum dimensions) and section 9 (Maximum weight) of the regulations.
2. When operating a vehicle under this section, the person operating the vehicle shall comply with the following sections of the regulation to the same extent as if the vehicle were operating under an over-weight or over-dimensional permit.
  - section 11 (restricted bridges)
  - section 15 (over-dimensional safety requirements)
  - section 16 (escort vehicles)
3. When a vehicle is operated under this section, the following information shall be forwarded to Transport Engineering Branch as notice of the move.
