SECTION C: COLLISION INFORMATION

The Permit Holder must investigate and document every traffic incident involving a commercial vehicle over 4,500 kilograms registered to the Permit Holder for incidents that resulted in:

- a) The death of a person;
- b) An injury requiring treatment by a medical doctor; and/or
- c) A condition that causes an employee to lose consciousness.

At any time, Alberta Transportation may verify that the Permit Holder has undertaken the following actions:

- a) Conducted incident evaluations;
- b) Determined incident preventability;
- c) Prepared and retained incident reports; and
- d) Took preventive measures to avoid similar incident in the future.

SECTION D: PERMIT CONDITIONS

Permit Holder must have and maintain an acceptable Carrier Profile (including R-Factor score), general NSC compliance (including good audit score) and permit compliance (including good Permit Inspection score, as applicable).

1. The Permit Holder must have and implement written policy/procedures which identify they effectively monitor the compliance of each driver to the permit conditions for the Quad Axle Semi-Trailer and/or 9/10 Axle B-Train.
2. The Permit Holder must have and implement specific written policies and procedures identified in their safety program to ensure that all conditions of the permit are being complied with at all times.
3. The Permit Holder agrees to abide by the requirements of the permit. Non-compliance with the permit conditions may result in the cancellation of the permit.

SECTION E: SAFETY REVIEW

Prior to issuance of the permit, Alberta Transportation will determine:

- a) Whether this permit application is complete;
- b) Whether the following information is acceptable:
 - i. The contents of the Applicant's current Carrier Profile;
 - ii. Past compliance to all safety standards and regulations in Alberta or in any other jurisdiction in which the Applicant has or continues to operate;
 - iii. The results of an NSC audit;
 - iv. Content and implementation of the Applicant's written policies and/or procedures regarding driver training on compliance for operation of a Tridem Drive – Quad Axle Semi-Trailer;
 - v. Content and implementation of Applicant's written policies and/or procedures regarding the Applicant's compliance to all permit conditions; and
 - vi. Any other information Alberta Transportation considers appropriate.

At the end of this preliminary review, Alberta Transportation may:

- a) Issue the permit for the full year;
- b) Issue the permit with a reduced time period;
- c) Apply conditions to be satisfied prior to issuing or renewing the permit;
- d) Table the application until it is considered complete or the Applicant is verified as being in compliance; and
- e) Deny permit issuance.

Incomplete applications may be returned to the Applicant to provide required information.
