DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION REGISTRAR'S EXEMPTION

The Assistant Deputy Minister of Safety and Policy Division, of Alberta Transportation, pursuant to section 40 of Alberta's *Commercial Vehicle Safety Regulation* (CVSR) AR121/2009, subject to the conditions and restrictions noted below, hereby exempts a person operating a commercial vehicle that is registered as a Class 2 commercial vehicle under section 77(1)(b) and (2)(g) of the Operator Licensing and Vehicle Control Regulation (AR 320/2002), or a commercial vehicle that is operated under contract with a farmer for the purpose of hauling hay or straw, used either singly or in combination with one or more trailers, from sections 2(f) and 17(3) of Alberta's *Commercial Vehicle Safety Regulation* AR 121/2009.

Conditions:

This exemption only applies when transporting stacks of round or rectangular bales of hay or straw within a 50-kilometre radius of the load's place of origin if

- (a) the vehicle while transporting the load does not exceed
 - (i) the posted speed limit, where the posted speed limit is lower than 80 kilometres per hour, or

(ii) 80 kilometres per hour, where the posted speed limit is 80 kilometres per hour or higher, and

(b) the vehicle is not operated on any highway or portion of a highway listed in Schedule 7 of the CVSR, except to cross the highway.

The requirements as outlined in s. 17(4) in the Commercial Vehicle Safety Regulation still apply to farmers. Farmers are still required to ensure their hay bales are secured to the extent that a reasonable person would agree the hay bales are contained, immobilized, and adequately secured in such a way that they do not pose a traffic safety risk.

This exemption expires on December 1, 2022.
