Precedent D1

Exemptions:

Exemption from Part 3 (Documentation) and Part 5 (Means of Containment) except for Section 5.1.1(3) of the Transportation of Dangerous Goods Regulations, as adopted by the Dangerous Goods Transportation and Handling Regulation, for the road transportation of residues (less than 10% of maximum fill limit) of flammable liquids, corrosive liquids or any combination of the two contained in pumping units at oilfield operations.

Conditions:

- 1. The means of containment or vehicles transporting the residues shall display four placards in accordance with Part 4 (Dangerous Goods Safety Marks) of the Regulations and as shown in the Appendix to Part 4 for Class 3, Flammable Liquids. The UN number shall be UN2924.
- 2. For the purposes of emergency response and reporting requirements, the consignment should be treated as:

"UN2924, RESIDUE LAST CONTAINED - MIXED OILFIELD PRODUCTION FLUIDS. TREAT AS FLAMMABLE LIQUID, CORROSIVE, N.O.S., CLASS 3 (8) - MAY RELEASE HAZARDOUS VAPOUR."

- 3. A copy of this permit shall accompany each load and the driver shall be made aware of the permit location.
- 4. This permit exempts the permit holder from only those Part(s) or Section(s) of the Regulations identified above. To qualify for the exemptions shown, all permit conditions must be adhered to and all remaining applicable provisions of the Act and Regulations or other related legislation must be complied with.
- 5. If the conditions of this permit are not met, the permit holder shall be in full compliance with the Act and Regulations and the permit shall no longer be applicable.
- 6. This permit is valid only in Alberta.
- 7. All those involved with the handling, offering for transport, and transporting the dangerous goods identified shall be trained and certified in accordance with Part 6 of the Regulations.
