Precedent N

Exemptions:

Exemption from Part 3 (Documentation) and Part 5 (Means of Containment) except for Section 5.1.1(3) of the Transportation of Dangerous Goods Regulations, as adopted by the Dangerous Goods Transportation and Handling Regulation, for the road transportation of dangerous goods (Petroleum Liquids and Gases) used for testing and calibrating volume measuring devices in the petroleum industry and in portable test facilities for well head production evaluation.

Conditions:

- 1. The required safety marks must be displayed on the means of containment in accordance with Part 4 (Dangerous Goods Safety Marks) of the Regulations.
- 2. For the purposes of emergency response and release reporting, the consignment should be treated as:

"THE TESTING AND CALIBRATION DEVICES MAY CONTAIN RESIDUE AMOUNTS OF THE DANGEROUS GOODS INDICATED BY THE SAFETY MARKS".

- 3. The total maximum water capacity of all the means of containment on board cannot exceed 2500 litres.
- 4. The equipment is not used to transport dangerous goods and is drained to the maximum possible extent before moving.
- 5. A copy of this permit shall accompany each load and the driver shall be made aware of the permit location.
- 6. This permit exempts the permit holder from only those Part(s) or Section(s) of the Regulations identified above. To qualify for the exemptions shown, all permit conditions must be adhered to and all remaining applicable provisions of the Act and Regulations or other related legislation must be complied with.
- 7. If the conditions of this permit are not met, the permit holder shall be in full compliance with the Act and Regulations and the permit shall no longer be applicable.
- 8. This permit is valid only in Alberta.
- 9. All those involved with the handling, offering for transport, and transporting the dangerous goods identified shall be trained and certified in accordance with Part 6 of the Regulations.
