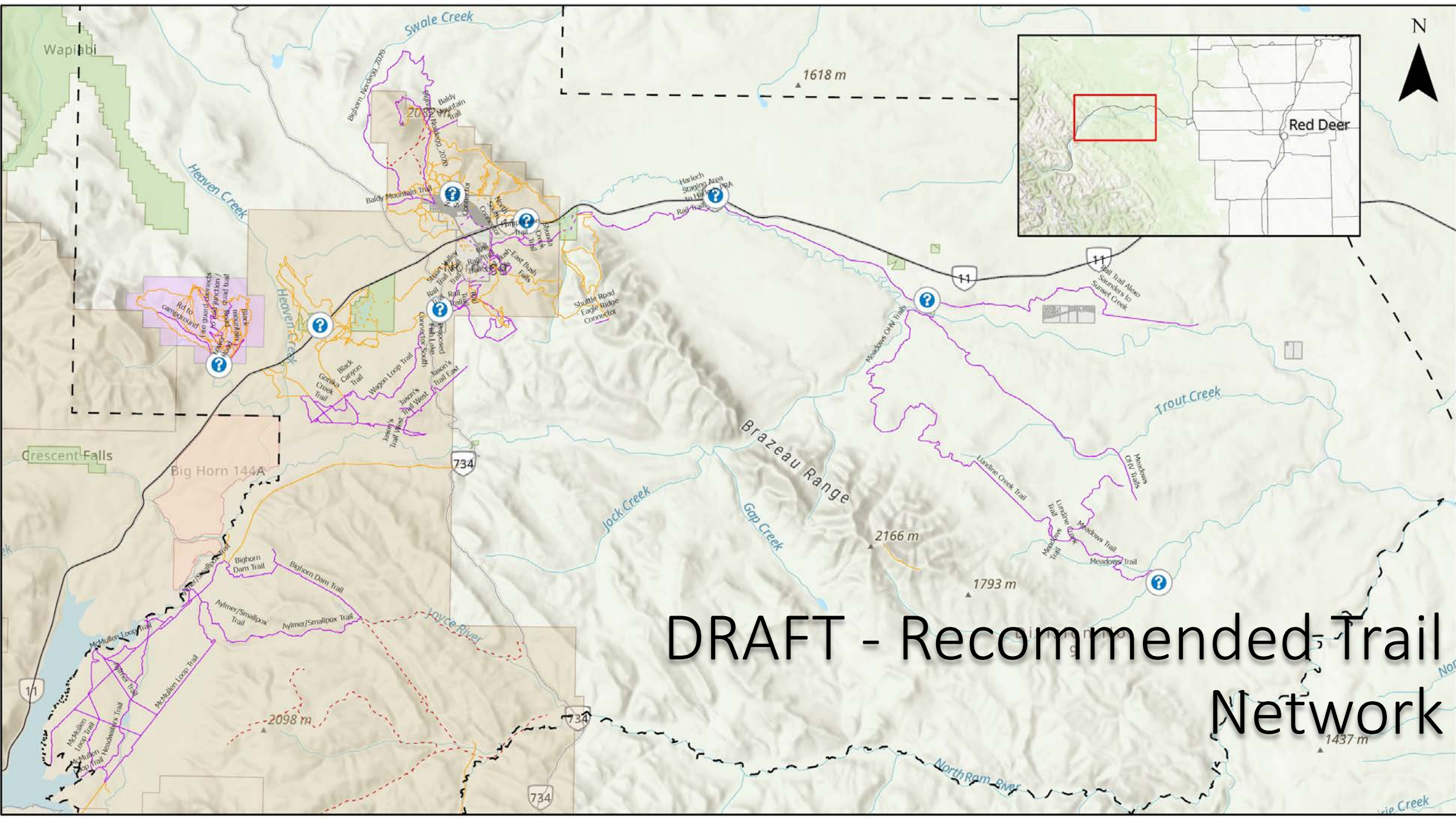

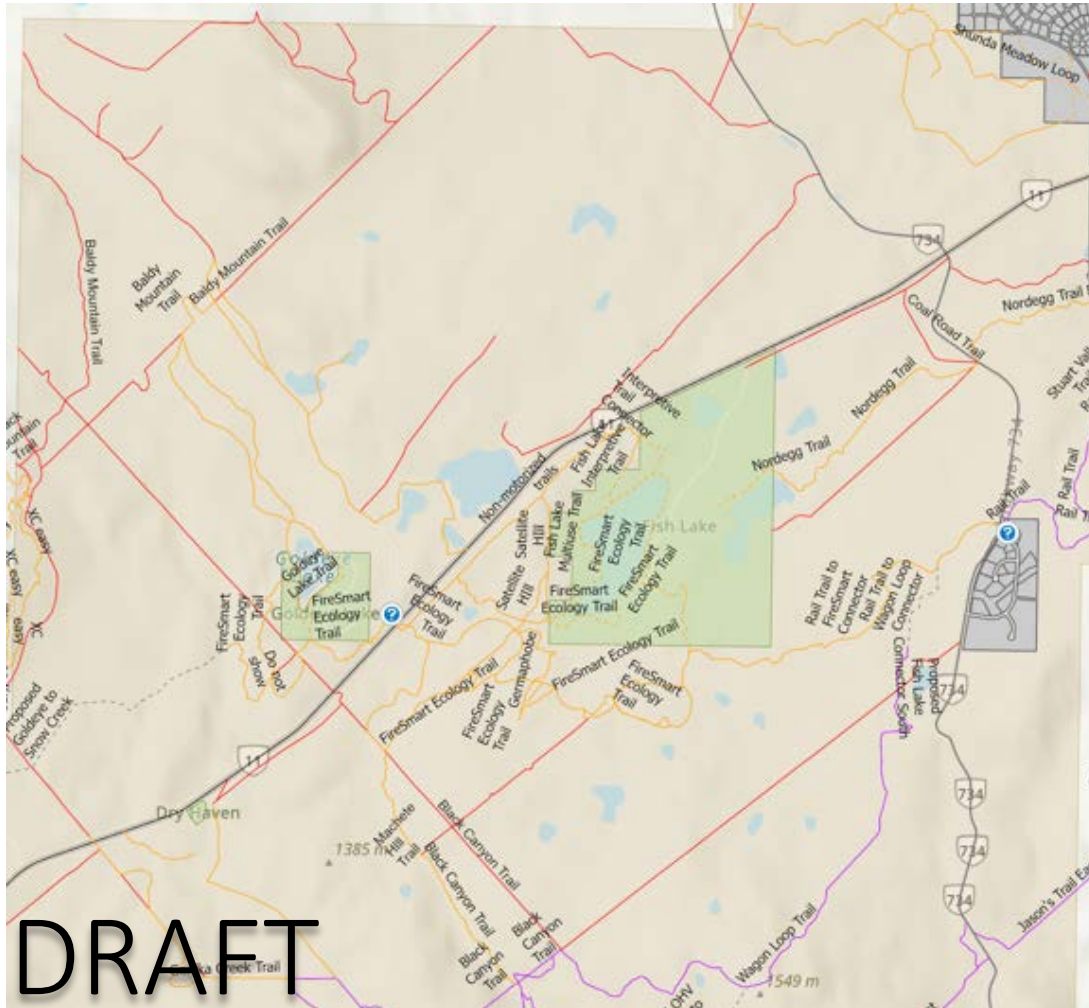

Goldeye – Fish Lake

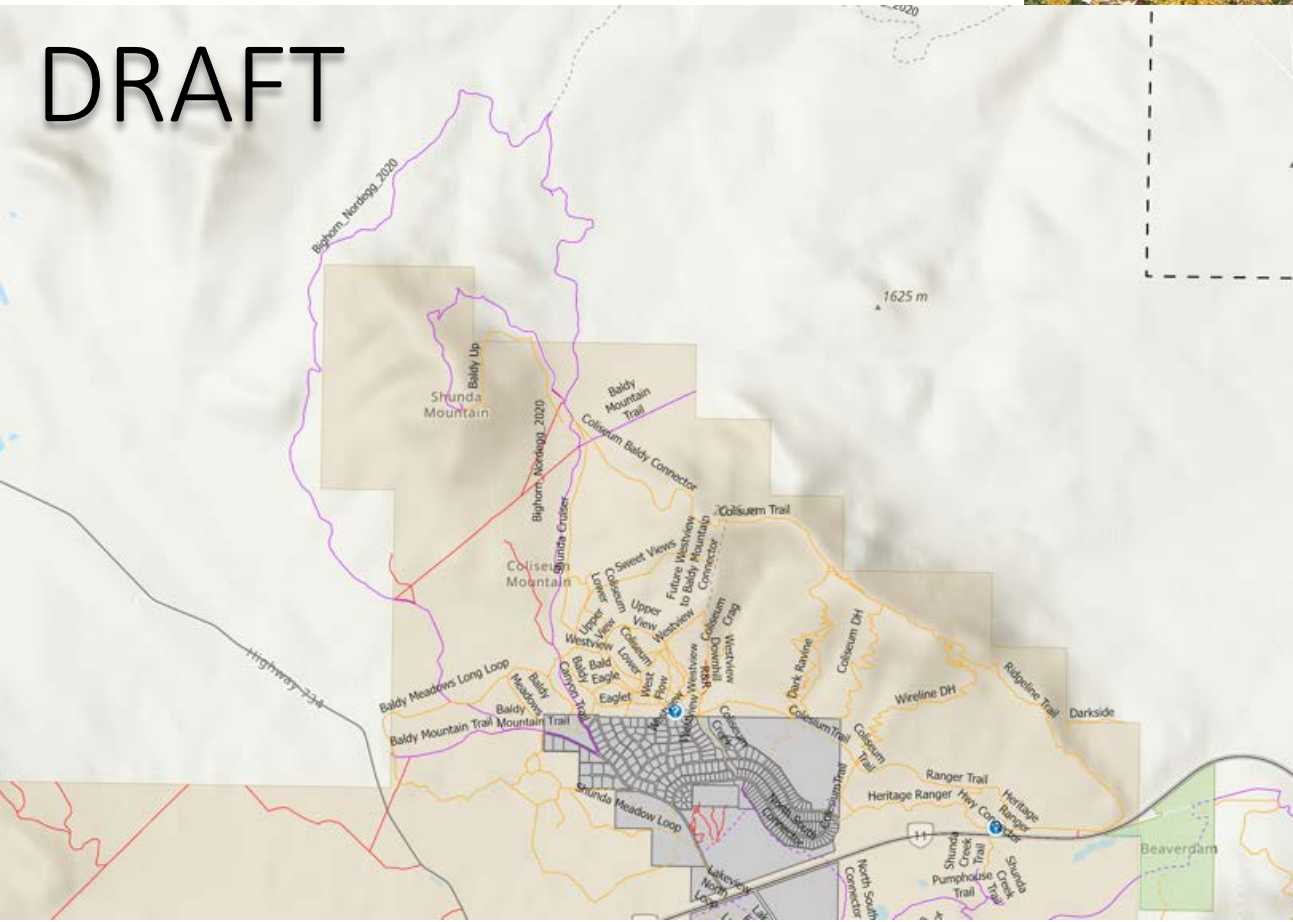




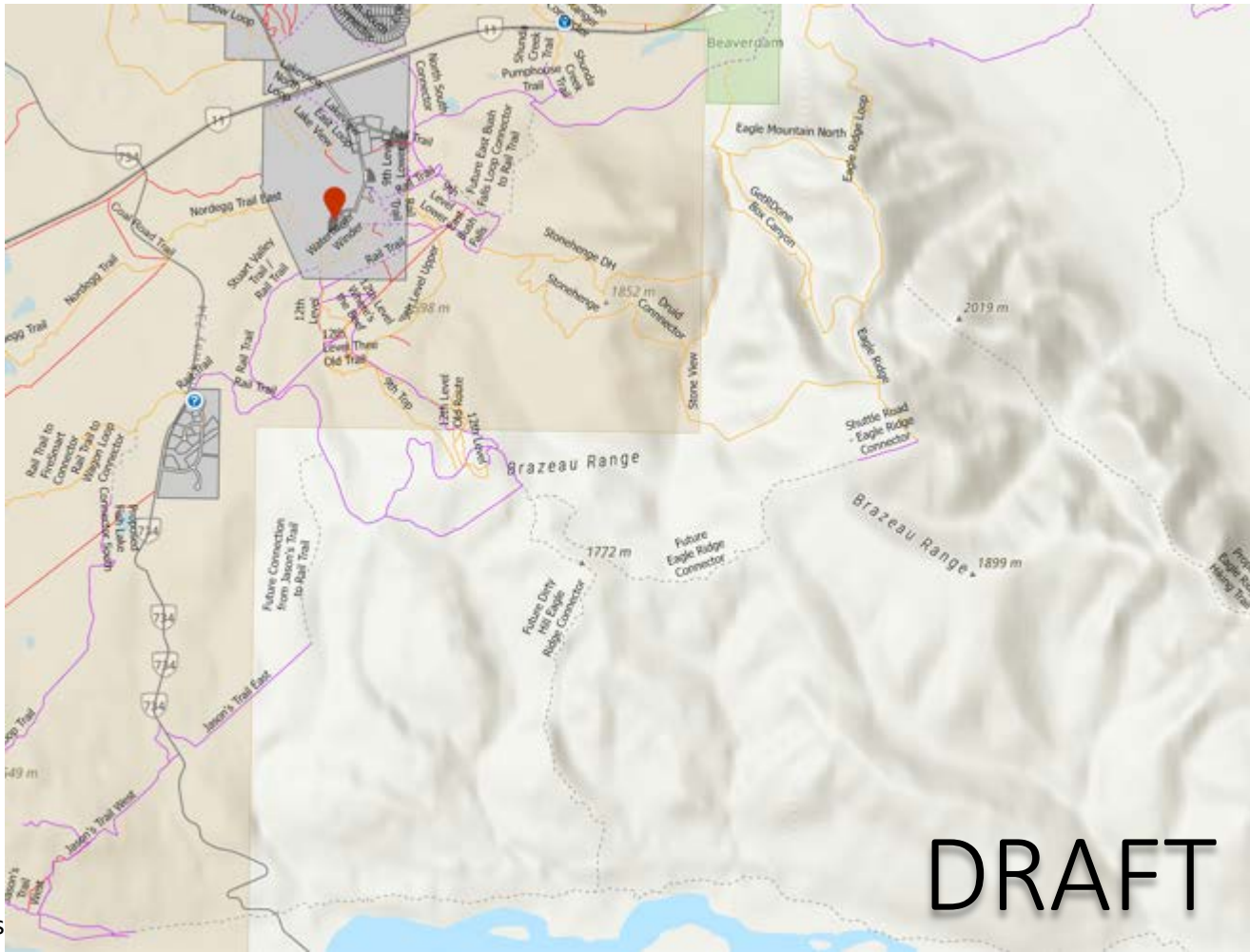
