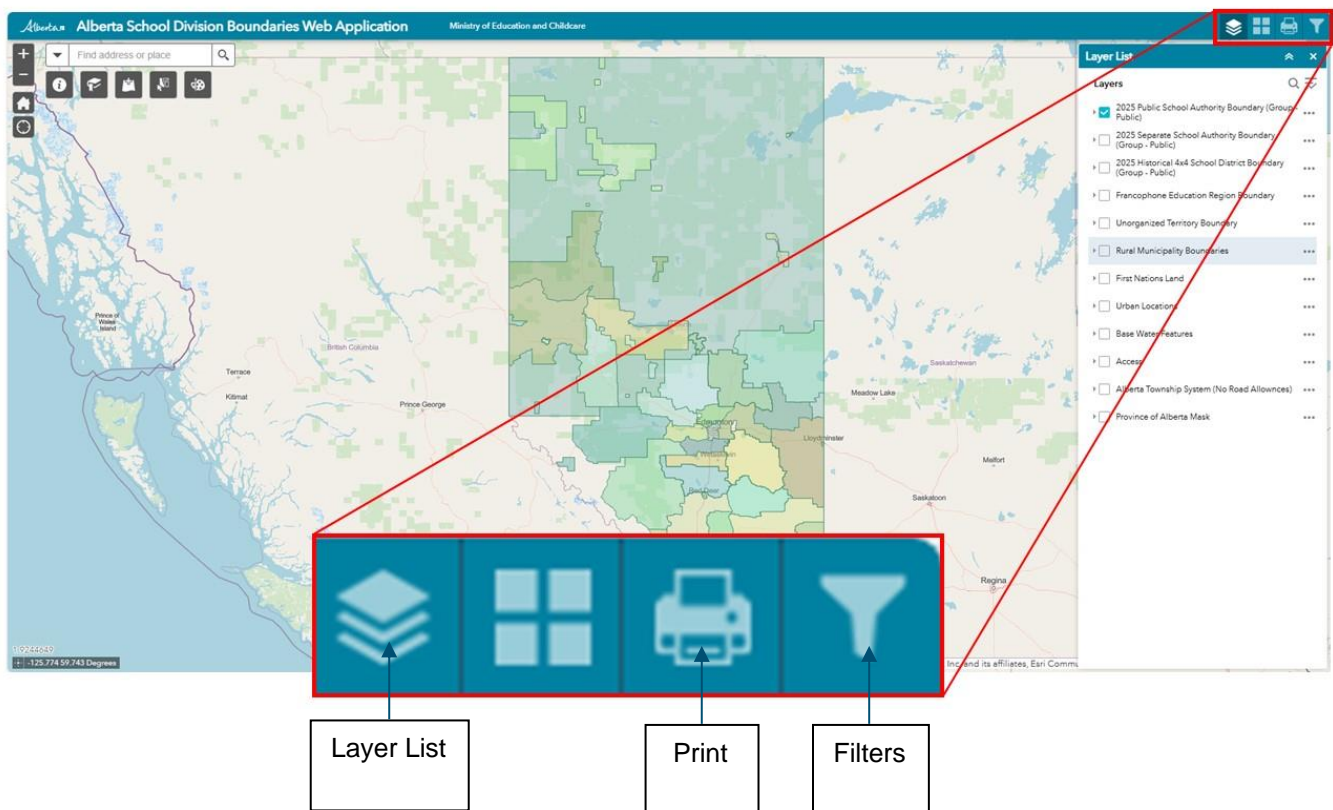
User guide

Welcome to the Alberta [school division web map](https://geospatial.alberta.ca/go/schooldivisionboundaries) quick user guide.

The online map tool provides current information on the boundaries for Alberta's public and separate school divisions, Francophone education regions and historical school districts. It can be used to:

- find out which school division a student resides in
- see which school division someone can vote in during school board elections
- support school division transportation planning
- support the establishment of separate school districts

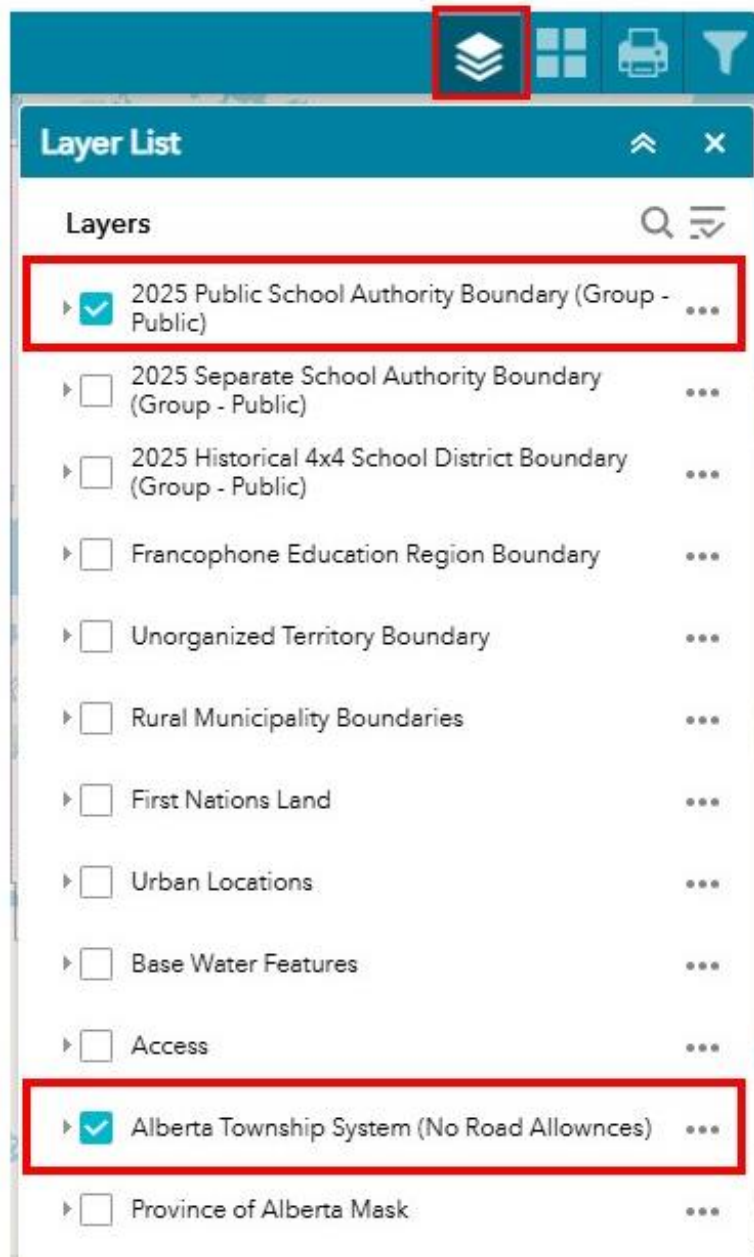
The basic web map tools are in the top right of the application.



Layer list


The layers list is open by default when you open the web map and can be found on the right-hand side of the screen. Select the layer you would like to view by clicking on the checkbox beside the layer name, and it will appear on the map once the information has loaded to the webpage. Public School Authority Boundaries are on by default.

Tip: You can have more than 1 layer selected at a time



Print

This option will print a map of the area showing on your screen. You can title your map, select a paper / print size under the layout option, and select the file type you want to use to print under the format option (some examples include PDF, GIF, JPG). Selecting “print” will create a list of map files you can open and save.

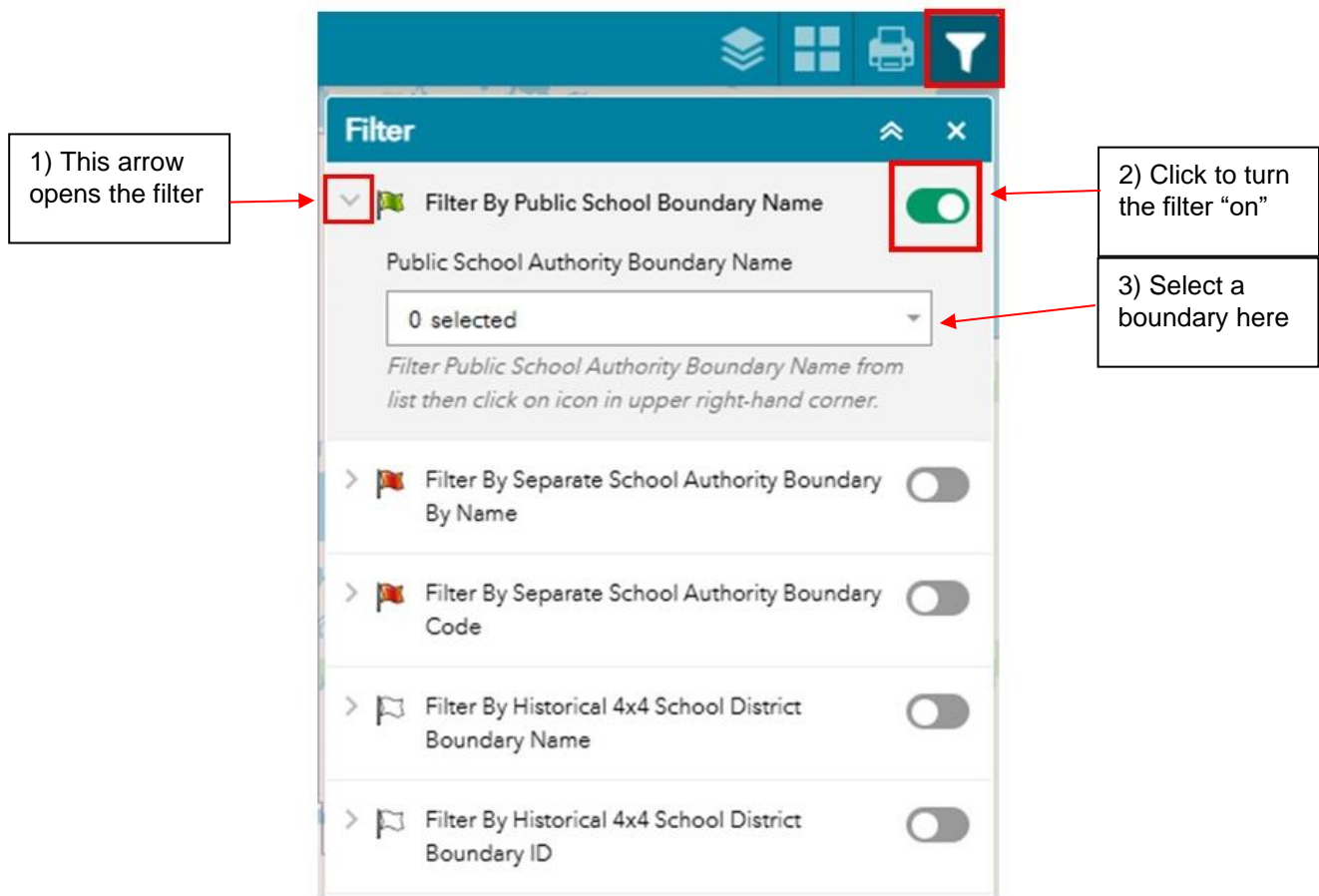

Filters

This option allows you to zoom into a specific boundary selection.

To use the filters:

- 1) Open the filter option by clicking on the arrow left of its flag icon
- 2) Turn the filter on using the toggle on the right hand side
- 3) Select a boundary to view from the drop-down menu
