GET INSPECTED.

From powerboats to paddleboards, all watercraft require inspection for invasive species.

ENTERING FROM THE SOUTH OR EAST BORDER?

Watercraft inspection stations are located along Alberta highways near popular border crossings.



IS THE WATERCRAFT INSPECTION STATION OPEN?

YES

Every watercraft must be inspected no matter where it is travelling from.

IF NOT

Watercraft arriving from the south or east must get inspected within 7 days and before launching in Alberta's waters.
