Trapline Site Information

Identify a trapline site where the trapline structures are located by GPS or ATS legal location. Trapline structures are to conform to the Disturbance Standard for Trapping Structures on Registered Fur Management Licences on Public Lands.

LAT/LONG: Identify specific GPS location of the trapline site. GPS coordinate should be located central within the trapline site, or

ATS Legal: Identify to the nearest quarter section the location of the trapline site where the trapping structures are located.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Departmental staff will review any exceedance or variance to the Disturbance Standard and will assess if the variance is still acceptable. If acceptable, the department will process the registration and notify the RFML holder via email. If there are concerns with the variances listed, a departmental representative will contact the RFML holder to discuss options to address the variance.

Trapline Structure authorizations will be issued per trapline site as entered in the departmental database and will be valid for the life of the RFML as long as the RFML holder remains unchanged. Should the RFML ownership change as managed by Alberta Forestry and Parks;

1. The new RFML holder is required to register any structures transferred with the RFML to ensure structures are tracked as part of the assignment process.
2. Any structures not assigned as part of the RFML process are required to be removed from public land prior to RFML assignment.
3. Should the RFML become cancelled, removal of all trapline structures and debris from trapline sites must occur.
