NOTICE OF CLOSURE

WHEREAS, the lands described in this Notice are administered under the *Public Lands Act* (the “Act”);

WHEREAS, the area of land described in Part A of Schedule 4 of the *Public Lands Administration Regulation* (Alberta Regulation 187/2011) (the “Regulation”) has been declared, pursuant to section 178 of the Regulation, to be a public land use zone known as the Kananaskis Country Public Land Use Zone (the “Zone”);

WHEREAS, the area in the Zone identified as “Special K” is designated as a provincial trail;

WHEREAS, bridge construction is taking place in the Zone on the provincial trail identified as “Special K”, from June 9, 2026 and until further notice, for the purpose of trail maintenance;

WHEREAS, pursuant to section 199.4 of the Regulation, the director may close any part of a provincial trail for the purpose of trail maintenance;

WHEREAS, pursuant to section 199.5 of the Regulation, no person shall enter on or occupy part of a provincial trail that has been closed under section 199.4(1) of the Regulation;

THEREFORE, I, Trevor Poth, being a Director designated under section 5 of the Act, hereby provide notice pursuant to section 199.4 of the Regulation that:

1. The provincial trail in the Zone and identified as “Special K” is closed to public access.
2. Unless permitted under section 3 of this Notice, no person shall enter on or occupy the provincial trail in the Zone and identified as “Special K”.
3. The following persons may enter on or occupy the provincial trail in the Zone identified as “Special K”:
 - a. Any person who has been granted specific authorization by the Department of Forestry and Parks on or after the effective date of this Notice.

THIS Notice comes into effect at 00:01 on the 9th day of June, 2026 and is in effect until further notice.

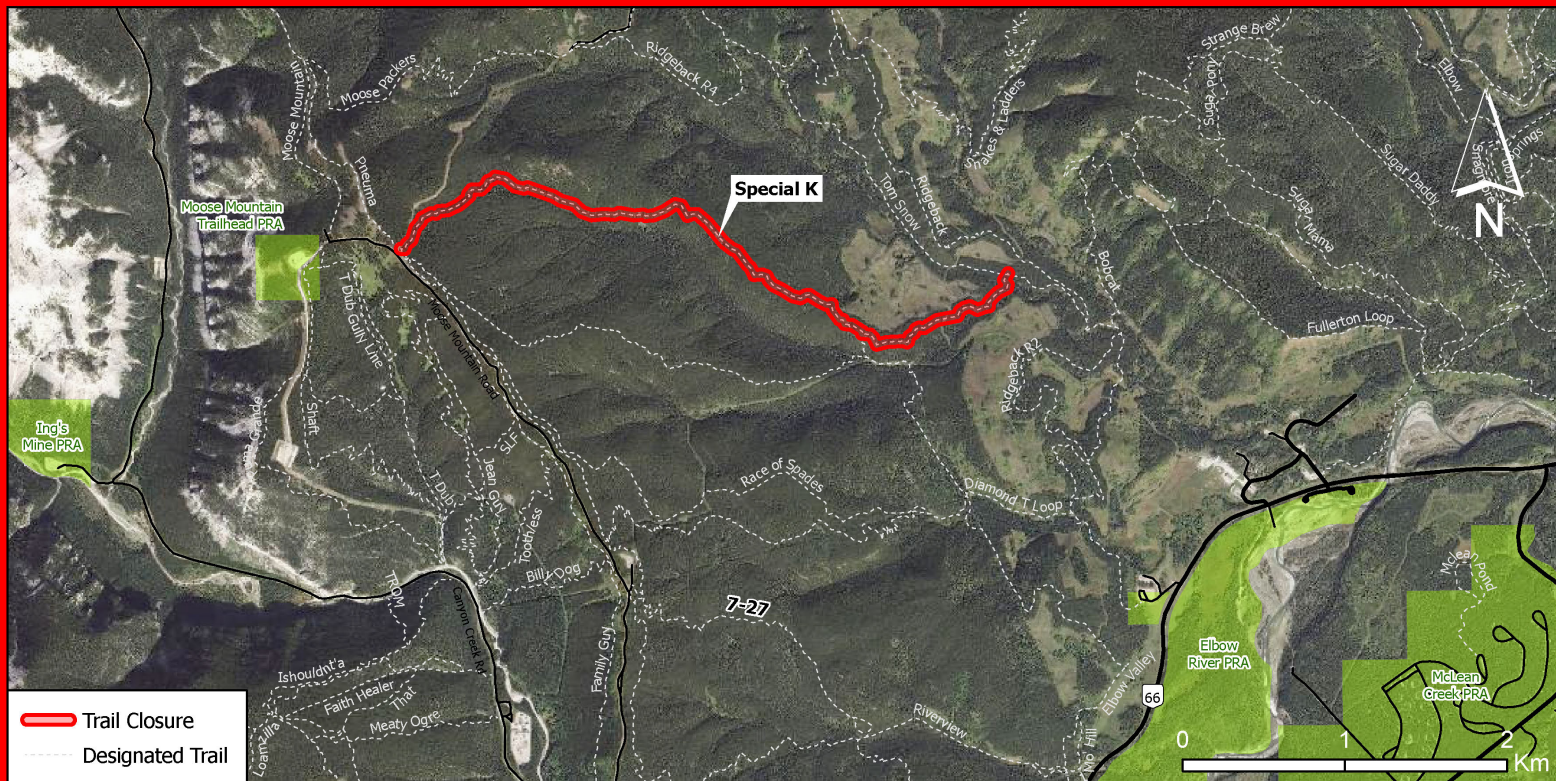
