Public information and warning: Violent Offender Released

In the interest of public safety, the Edmonton Police Service is issuing the following warning; James BRASHKO was recently released from the Edmonton Maximum Institution after he completed a 4 year sentence for 2 counts of Break, Enter and Theft.

BRASHKO is considered by police to be a Violent Offender who poses a risk of significant harm to the community to re-offend violently.

The Edmonton Police Service is issuing this information and warning after careful deliberation of all related issues, including privacy concerns, in the belief that it is clearly in the public interest to inform the members of the community. BRASHKO will be residing in the Edmonton area and will be monitored by the Behavioral Assessment Unit of the Edmonton Police Service.

Members of the public are advised that the intent of this process is to enable citizens to take suitable precautionary measures. Releasing this information is NOT intended to encourage people to engage in any form of vigilante action.
