Public information and warning: Sexual Offender Released

In the interest of public safety, the Edmonton Police Service is issuing the following warning: **Robert Terry TAUBER** has been released from the Saskatchewan Penitentiary where he served two years for Sexual Assault, Sexual Interference X 2, Fail To Comply With A Probation Order and Fail To Comply With An Undertaking.

TAUBER is considered by police to be an opportunistic sexual offender who has a history of sexually assaulting children. TAUBER has attended some sexual offender treatment programs but has not successfully completed these programs. In the absence of any successful treatment, we believe that he continues to pose a risk of significant harm to the community.

The Edmonton Police Service is issuing this information and warning after careful deliberation of all related issues, including privacy concerns, and in the belief that it is clearly in the public interest to inform the members of the community about TAUBER.

Caucasian male, 29 years old, 170 cm, 59 kg. Brown hair, brown eyes, Scar right upper lip, Scar left thumb, Scar left knee, Deformed little fingers



Members of the public are advised that the intent of this process is to enable citizens to take suitable precautionary measures. Releasing this information is NOT intended to encourage people to engage in any form of vigilante action.

This information is released under the authority of the *FOIP Act*, RSA 2000, C. F-25.

The information in this release is that which was verifiable prior to the release time indicated. Continued investigation and review could result in additional information or clarification.
