Public information and warning: Violent Offender Released

In the interest of public safety, the Edmonton Police Service is issuing the following warning; **Timothy PREDDY** is a convicted violent offender, including intimate partner violence, and the Edmonton Police Service has reasonable grounds to believe he will commit another violent offence against someone while in the community

PREDDY will be residing in the Edmonton area. The Edmonton Police Service is seeking a recognizance order on PREDDY and he will be closely monitored by the Behavioural Assessment Unit of the Edmonton Police Service.

PREDDY has been placed on a series of court ordered conditions including:

- Must abide by a curfew of 10 PM to 6 AM daily.
- Must abstain from the purchase, possession or consumption of alcohol and drugs, including marijuana.
- Must not be found in any tavern, bar, lounge, nightclub or any establishment where the primary focus is the consumption or sale of alcohol.
- Must not associate, directly or indirectly, with any person known to have a criminal record or awaiting criminal prosecution.
- Must not own, possess, carry or have in a place of residence any weapons.

The Edmonton Police Service is issuing this information and warning after careful deliberation of all related issues, including privacy concerns, in the belief that it is clearly in the public interest to inform the members of the community.
