

Release of High-Risk Offender – Daniel Christopher LEONARD

In the interest of public safety, the Calgary Police Service is issuing the following public information and warning in regards to the release of a high risk offender.

Daniel Christopher LEONARD, 45, is being released to the Calgary community, August 15, 2023 after serving a custodial sentence for Sexual Assault

He has multiple convictions for Sexual Assault and Indecent Acts that have resulted in custodial sentences. The majority of his crimes have occurred against females that are unknown to him.

LEONARD will be monitored by the Calgary Police Service High Risk Offender Program.

He is described as a white male, 180cm tall (5'11"), and 89kg (195lbs), and is bald with brown eyes. A photo of LEONARD is available on The City of Calgary Newsroom.

The Calgary Police Service is issuing this information and warning after careful deliberation and consideration of all related issues, including privacy concerns, in the belief that it is clearly in the public interest to inform the members of the community of the release of LEONARD.

Members of the public are advised that the intent of the process is to enable members of the public to take suitable precautionary measures and not to embark on any form of vigilante action.
