Notice is hereby given that a vote of the electors will be held on the following:

Based on the findings of the Village of Cremona viability review, which one of the two options below do you support for the future of Cremona? (Select one only)

Option 1. The Village of Cremona remains a village.

Option 2. The Village of Cremona dissolves and Cremona becomes a hamlet in Mountain View County.

Voting will take place on the 23rd day of September 2026, between the hours of 4:00 p.m. and 8:00 p.m., and the 24th day of September 2026, between the hours of 10:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m.

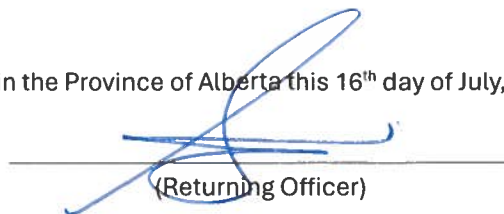
Voting stations will be located at: **Cremona Community Hall**

In order to vote, you must produce for inspection one or more of the acceptable forms of identification required by Section 53 of the *Local Authorities Elections Act*. If an elector's name is not contained in the permanent electors register, they are required to complete an application with the Returning Officer in the prescribed form.

Special ballots (mail-in) are available for electors whose names are contained in the permanent electors register and who are unable to vote at the voting station on the days of the vote. Applications for a special ballot may be made in writing, by telephone, or by email to the Returning Officer.

Special ballots must be returned to the Returning Officer (in Edmonton) by 12:00 p.m. (noon) on September 22, 2026.
