The City's Planning Department delivers most required planning projects in-house and works on many planning issues. The City of Lethbridge has hosted numerous Land Use Planner interns in previous years that have gone on to have successful careers in the Planning profession.

About the City of Lethbridge

Living in Lethbridge, you'll have an opportunity to explore over 234 km of walking/biking trails, 70 parks, 14 pools and arenas, 10 arts and culture facilities and three post-secondary institutions. The Oldman River Valley Parks System that cuts through the community is one of the largest urban parks systems in North America and has various recreational opportunities as well as bike and pedestrian pathways. The Cavendish Farms Centre is home to the Cor Van Raay YMCA and has an aquatics centre, public gymnasiums, equipment room, indoor running track, curling rink, two skating rinks and other features. The Enmax Centre is home to the WHL's Lethbridge Hurricanes and hosts multiple concerts and events. Lethbridge is the epicenter for three UNESCO World Heritage Sites which are within a radius of 150 km:

- Writing-On-Stone Provincial Park
- Waterton Lakes National Park
- Head-Smashed-In Buffalo Jump

The Rocky Mountains and two Ski Resorts are within a 90-minute drive. As well, there are some other unique services available to our community:

- Three post-secondary institutions (University of Lethbridge, Lethbridge College & Red Crow College)
- Nikka Yuko Japanese Gardens is open year-round and hosts the annual Winter Light Festival from December to February
- The Alberta Birds of Prey Centre is located just outside of Lethbridge and is open for the public from May to September.
- Southern Alberta Art Gallery (SAAG) is in the heart of downtown.
- Casa is the home for arts in Southern Alberta and offers courses and programing in arts.
