WHEREAS: Guillain-Barré Syndrome (GBS), Chronic Inflammatory Demyelinating Polyneuropathy (CIDP) and their variants are rare disorders affecting people of all ages, genders, and ethnic backgrounds;

AND WHEREAS: The cause of these disorders is not completely understood, and recovery can be unpredictable with varying residual effects;

AND WHEREAS: The Government of Alberta is committed to providing appropriate supports and services to meet Albertans' health care needs, including individuals living with GBS/CIDP;

AND WHEREAS: The Government of Alberta commends the GBS/CIDP Foundation of Canada for their ongoing support of patients and families living with GBS/CIDP and variants by providing supports, advocacy and education; raising awareness; and supporting research.

THEREFORE: I, ADRIANA LAGRANGE, MINISTER OF PRIMARY AND PREVENTATIVE HEALTH SERVICES, PURSUANT TO SECTION 3(1) (C) OF THE SPECIAL DAYS ACT, HEREBY DECLARE MAY AS GUILLAIN-BARRÉ SYNDROME AND CHRONIC INFLAMMATORY DEMYELINATING POLYNEUROPATHY AWARENESS MONTH IN PERPETUITY IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA.
