



DECLARATION

WHEREAS: On April 7, 2018, in the aftermath of the tragic Humboldt bus crash, a 21-year-old Alberta hockey player named Logan Boulet became an organ donor;

AND WHEREAS: Just weeks prior to his death, Logan registered as a donor and shared his wishes with his family; Logan's gift saved the lives of six others, and his story inspired thousands of Albertans and people around the world to register as organ and tissue donors;

AND WHEREAS: Organ and tissue transplant is often the only way to save lives for people with serious or life-threatening disease and injuries;

AND WHEREAS: Green Shirt Day is observed annually to honor the legacy of Logan Boulet and the Humboldt Broncos, and to raise awareness about the importance of organ and tissue donation;

AND WHEREAS: The Government of Alberta encourages and supports a culture of donation and is committed to strengthening Alberta's organ and tissue donation program; and that by increasing the number of registered donors and reducing the number of people waiting for a transplant, more families will have the gift of time with their loved ones.

THEREFORE: I, ADRIANA LAGRANGE, MINISTER OF PRIMARY AND PREVENTATIVE HEALTH SERVICES, PURSUANT TO SECTION 3(1)(A) OF THE SPECIAL DAYS ACT, HEREBY DECLARE APRIL 7 AS GREEN SHIRT DAY IN PERPETUITY IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA.
