WHEREAS: Myeloma, also known as multiple myeloma, is a type of blood cancer that develops in the plasma cells found in the bones;

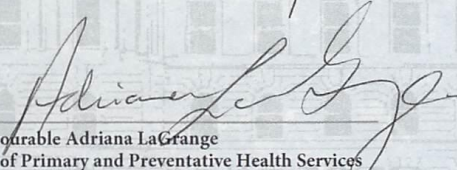
AND WHEREAS: While the causes of myeloma are not fully understood, research suggests it may be related to weakened immune function, genetic factors, and environmental exposures;

AND WHEREAS: The Government of Alberta commends the ongoing efforts of organizations committed to supporting individuals living with myeloma through advocacy, education, and research.
