WHEREAS: Cerebral palsy is a neuromotor disability that affects approximately 3.3 people in every thousand;

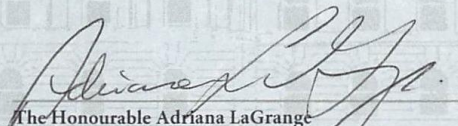
AND WHEREAS: Cerebral palsy is a term used to describe a group of conditions affecting body movement and muscle coordination, and not a disease;

AND WHEREAS: Cerebral palsy affects all levels of society and all levels of socioeconomic status, an estimated 17 million people worldwide;

AND WHEREAS: The Cerebral Palsy Association in Alberta (CPAA) is a leader in advocating for persons with disabilities and is the primary centre for providing programs, services and information on treatments, resources and services relating to cerebral palsy.

THEREFORE: I, ADRIANA LAGRANGE, MINISTER OF PRIMARY AND PREVENTATIVE HEALTH SERVICES, PURSUANT TO SECTION 3(1)(A) OF THE SPECIAL DAYS ACT, HEREBY DECLARE OCTOBER 6 AS WORLD CEREBRAL PALSY DAY IN PERPETUITY IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA.
