**Stream Definition:**

Under the legislative framework (authorities and timelines) of the *Child Youth and Family Enhancement Act* (CYFEA) and related legislation, child intervention work is performed to protect children and youth under 18 years of age from harmful situations involving abuse, neglect and other circumstances and ensure their well-being.

Primary responsibilities include:

- Intake: Receiving and assessing reports of child safety concerns and determining child protection needs
- Safety assessment: conducting risk evaluations, assessing safety and determining intervention actions related child safety concerns
- Protective actions and apprehensions: implementing statutory intervention measures such as apprehensions for a child's immediate safety and well-being
- Guardianship responsibilities: assuming legal authority, exercising decision-making and care when guardianship is assumed under the Act
- Ongoing Case Management: managing intervention case files, developing and monitoring plans to address identified risks, supporting family reunification where appropriate, and ensuring long-term stability for children and youth

Child intervention work is legally mandated, requiring time-sensitive actions and decision-making to address safety concerns and uphold the rights of children and youth.
