

Registrar's Decisions: Notification (RDN) 01/2026: Specialized Business Functions (SBF) Motor Vehicle Information Products (MVIPs) – Incremental Decision

Access to Motor Vehicle Information Regulation (AMVIR)

Section 2(1)(j.2) of the *Access to Motor Vehicle Information Regulation* (AMVIR) was amended on November 26, 2025, to replace the reference to the Insurance Crime Prevention Bureau, a division of the Insurance Bureau of Canada, with Équité Association.

I. Decisions

To comply with the requirements of the *Access to Motor Vehicle Information Regulation* (AMVIR) AR 140/2003 as amended, to reflect recent AMVIR amendments, and to further strengthen, clarify, and manage the disclosure of personal information from Alberta's Motor Vehicle Electronic System (MOVES), the Registrar of Motor Vehicle Services (the "Registrar") amends Registrar's Decisions: Notification 04/2020 as follows:

- A. Replace paragraph 2(1)(j.2) under the heading, 3. AMVIR Purposes, on page 5/20, with the following text:

2(1)(j.2) (i) The Registrar may, on request, release information on the Registrar's motor vehicle information system, collected and compiled for the purpose of identifying licensed operators and registered owners of motor vehicles, only to the Équité Association for the purposes of investigating theft, fraud, possession of stolen property or any other illegal activity, offence or crime related to or associated with motor vehicles.

- B. Replace paragraph 2(1)(j.2)(i) under the heading, 5. Categories of Persons and/or Organizations, on page 9/20 with the following text:

2(1)(j.2) (i) The Registrar may, on request, release information on the Registrar's motor vehicle information system, collected and compiled for the purpose of identifying licensed operators and registered owners of motor vehicles, only to the Équité Association for the purposes of investigating theft, fraud, possession of stolen property or any other illegal activity, offence or crime related to or associated with motor vehicles.

II. Notification and Review Process

In accordance with section 4 of AMVIR, on request by a Recipient, identified above, the Registrar's decision is to **release**, on an ongoing basis, the Information specified in this notification.

This notification was published on June 29, 2026. Any person may, within sixty days after the date of this publication, ask the Information and Privacy Commissioner (IPC) to review the decision of the Registrar in accordance with Part 3, Division 2 of the *Access to Information Act*.

On the publication of this notification, in accordance with section 4(1) of AMVIR, notice is deemed to have been given for the current and any future releases of the category of information and of the person or category of persons to whom the information is released or not released, as described in the notification, for the purposes of notice under Part 3, Division 2 of the *Access to Information Act*.
