



Canadian Association of Energy Contractors (CAOEC) Permit

Alberta Transportation and Economic Corridors and the Canadian Association of Energy Contractors (CAOEC) have signed a Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) in an effort to maximize the productivity of the service rig industry, while ensuring safety on Alberta highways. Under this Agreement, an Oil and Gas Well Service Rig Permit may be issued to a contractor to grant conditional exemptions from select regulatory requirements, while operating in Alberta.

By submitting an application to Alberta Transportation and Economic Corridors to acquire the Oil and Gas Well Service Rig Permit, the contractor agrees to share its information with the CAOEC as it pertains to a:

- Contractor who is refused a permit or the renewal of a permit; or
- Contractor whose Permit is cancelled or suspended.

Alberta Transportation and Economic Corridors retains the right to regulate and monitor carriers under its progressive monitoring program. Where compliance issues are identified, or unacceptable levels of violations and/or collisions are incurred. Alberta Transportation and Economic Corridors may among other actions:

- Refuse to issue a permit identified under this agreement;
- Remove one or more conditional exemptions set out in this permit;
- Cancel or suspend a permit identified under this agreement;
- Change a contractor's safety fitness rating; or
- Cancel or suspend their safety fitness certificate.
