


If a permit has been issued pursuant to Section 62 of the *Traffic Safety Act* authorizing the movement of residual wood trucks, any and all of the following conditions shall apply in addition to any other conditions specified on the permit.

The dimensions allowed by this permit apply to an 8 Axle B-Train as shown in the following picture.



### General Conditions of Permit

1. This permit applies to an 8 axle B-Train transporting wood chips and residual wood products.
2. This permit allows the movement of wood chips and residual wood products at the dimensions noted on the permit, provided weights are not exceeded as regulated under [Commercial Vehicle Dimension and Weight Regulation](#).
3. Load must consist entirely of unsettled wood chips or residual wood products.
4. The driver must inspect the load within 40 km of origin and make any necessary adjustments to the load or tarp, to ensure load continues to be secured as required.
5. The [Commercial Vehicle Safety Regulation](#) and [National Safety Code \(NSC\) Standard 10](#) apply at all times.
6. Municipal approval must be obtained prior to travel on local roads under the direction, control and management of the municipality when weights exceed regulated limits.

### Dimensions

1. This permit allows increased dimensions for:
  - (a) the overall length ..... 27.50 metres
  - (b) the overall box length .. ..... 23.00 metres
  - (c) the overall height loaded ..... 4.80 metres
  - (d) the overall height of the trailer sidewall (box) ..... 4.15 metres
  - (e) the sum of the trailer wheelbases..... 19.50 metres
2. Any portion of the vehicle above 4.15 meters must be a soft body. This may include but is not limited to a tarp.
3. [Commercial Vehicle Dimension and Weight Regulation](#) applies to all other dimensions.

### Routes

Retrofitted and new manufactured extended length 8 Axle B-Trains hauling wood chips or residual wood products are restricted to travel between the locations / mills listed on the permit.

### Recertification of Trailers

All trailers that have been modified or retrofitted to extend the length of the trailer(s) must be recertified by the manufacturer. Proof of recertification by the manufacturer must be shown at the request of a peace officer.
