DIRECTOR'S ORDER

WHEREAS the Government of Alberta designated the Nakiska All-Season Resort Area on December 10, 2025 and is now under the administration of Tourism and Sport under the *All-season Resorts Act* and the associated specified provisions;

AND WHEREAS within the Nakiska All-Season Resort Area are popular trails including but not limited to Troll Falls, Stoney, Bill Milne, Hay Meadows, Skogan Pass;

AND WHEREAS the department's intent for public trail and recreation use within the Nakiska All-Season Resort Area is to continue in the form and manner as was occurring prior to December 10, 2025 until which time as a new All-Season Resort disposition is issued;

AND WHEREAS any changes to the public use of trails and recreational use will be consulted on through the public notice requirements under an All-Season Resort Disposition application to ensure the public is aware and can comment on changes;

AND WHEREAS under the section 48.1 of the Public Lands Administration Regulation the director may with respect to lands within an All-Season Resort Area not under disposition, issue an order to prohibit or restrict any use or activity for recreational purposes to prevent or reduce harm, injury or damage to any person, resource or thing within the area;

I, Rob Simieritsch, Executive Director, All-season Resorts of the Department of Tourism and Sport, duly designated under Ministerial Order 02/2025 as a director under the *All-season Resorts Act* and associated specified provision, DO HEREBY ORDER THAT:

1. Public use of existing trails may continue in the same form and manner which occurred prior to December 10, 2025
2. All posted signs continue to apply to trails and recreational activities in the area
3. The site is for day use only
4. Bicycle and equestrian use will be restricted to trails designated for those purposes
5. The following restrictions continue to apply:
 - a) No fires
 - b) No camping
 - c) No drones
 - d) No off-leash dog walking
 - e) No motorized activities




